5.HOWTOAPPLY

SINGLEWINDOWREGISTRATION

The printout of the online application along with documents is to be submitted to the Principal of concerned college at the time of admission.

APPLICATION REGISTRATION FEE

The Single Registration fee for all IHRD rcolleges under university of keralawill be Rs. 750/-(Rs. 250/-for SC/ST candidates). Application Registration fee payment will be accepted only through **SBI Collect** as per details in the IHRD admission portal. **Application Registration fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances**. The details of application Registration fee remitted should be entered in the admission portal while submitting the online application. **ApplicationswithoutapplicationRegistrationfee will be summarily rejected.**

FEECONCESSION/CAUTIONDEPOSIT

- 1. AllstudentsincludingSC/ST/OECcandidatesarerequiredtopayCautionDepositirrelevantofcategory
- 2. The SC/ST/OEC candidates are exempted from payment of the prescribed fee on condition that they will submitapplication for educational concession to the SC/ST Development Department in the prescribed form along withsupporting documents within 15 days from the date of admission. If they fail to do so, they should pay the prescribed fees. In case, the educational concession is not sanctioned by the SC development department, the student is liable to remit the entire fee. Sanctioning of educational concessions is also subject to the orders of SCDevelopmentDepartment/Governmentfromtimetotime.
- 3. All students including those eligible for any type of Educational Concession from various Departments/WelfareAgencies, except the SC/ST/OEC Category, should remit the entire fee as per the schedule. Any student who gets admission to Degree programme later discontinues, his/her study from any one of theCollegeofAppliedScience,managedbyIHRD,TCwillbeissuedasperconditionsspecifiedintheG.O.(MS)no. 319/2017 /H.Edn (J) dated 29-12-2017. i.e. In the event of a student withdrawing before the startingof the Course, the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of Rs.1,000/-(RupeesOne thousand only) will be refunded by the College. If a student leaves after the commencement of classes and if the vacated seat is consequentlyfilled by another studentby the last date of admission, theCollege will refund the fee collected after a deduction of the processing fee of Rs. 1,000/ - (Rupees One thousandonly) and proportionate deductions monthly proportionate of fee and hostel rent, where applicable. thevacatedseatisnotfilled, the candidate is eligible to get refund of the Caution depositonly. All suchrefundwillbeprocessed only afterclosure of Degree admission duringthe academic year 2023-24 by the University. 9.PREVENTION OFRAGGINGINCAMP

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Theinstitutionwilltakesternactionagainsttheoffenders. The cardinal points contained in the actare furnished below for information of the concerned.

SHORTTITLEANDEXTENT

- $1. \ The Act may be called the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1998.$
- 2. ItextendstothewholeoftheStateofKerala.

DEFINITION

"Ragging" meansdisplayof disorderly conduct, doing anyact which causes or is likely to cause physicalorpsychologicalharmorraiseapprehensionorfearorshameorembarrassmenttoastudentin any,educationalinstitutionandincludes.

- 1. Teasing, abusing of, playing practical jokes on or causing hurttosuch student;
- 2. Askingthestudenttodoanyactorperformsomethingwhichsuchstudentwillnotintheordinaryprogrammewillingly do.

PROHIBITIONOFRAGGING

Ragging with inorout side of any educational institution is strictly prohibited.

PENALTYOFRAGGING

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within, or outside, any educational institution, shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extent to two years and shall also beliable to a fine which may extend to tenthous and rupees.

DISMISSALOFSTUDENT

Anystudentconvictedofanoffenseundersection4shallalsobedismissed educationalinstitutionandsuchstudentshallnotbeadmittedinanyother periodofthreeyears fromthedateoforderofsuchdismissal.

SUSPENSIONOFSTUDENT

- 1. Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institutioncomplains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institutionshall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and, if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is

 accused of the offence, and shall, immediately, forward the complaint to the policestation having jurisdiction over the area in which heed ucational institution is situated for further action.
- 2. Where, one nquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is proved that there is no substance prima facie in the complaint received under subsection (1), he shall in timate the fact, in writing, to the complainant.
